WHY: Childhood Lead Poisoning remains a major environmental health issue in the United States. An estimated half a million children between the ages of 1 & 5 are living with elevated blood lead levels. Elevated levels of lead in developing children can cause damage to the nervous system & can cause developmental, behavioral & neurological disorders, all of which could be irreversible. The only way to know if a child has lead poisoning is to have them tested, even if they seem healthy.
