In 2019, the New Haven Health Department received 140 cases.
 Elevated blood lead level (EBLL) defined as $\geq 10 \mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$.
 125 cases dealing with 94 EBLL children were received.
 15 cases dealing with non-EBLL parental requests were received.
 Within 2019, 110 children were reported with venipunctures of 5 – 9 $\mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$.
